

HIV Planning Group Accomplishments, 2020

The **HIV Planning Group (HPG)** is a group of individuals united for the common purpose to contribute to HIV care and prevention planning across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Together, the HPG has developed the **Integrated HIV Prevention and Care Plan (IHPCP)**—a five-year plan that details principles, priorities, and actions to guide our collective national response to the HIV epidemic.



Held **1 in-person meeting** and adapted to **2 virtual meetings** for HPG Community Members, Planning Partners, the Dept. of Health, and guests



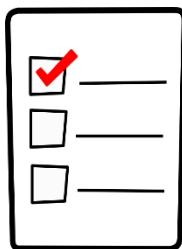
Virtually conducted the HPG **recruitment process** and selected **6** new community members to improve representation of the epidemic and efficacy across PA



Finalized PA's Revised 2017-2021 **IHPCP** and submitted for state publication



Assisted in the rollout of the **stigma needs assessment** and received responses from **over 1,500** SPBP clients



Evaluated the progress of **12** planning activities in the **IHPCP**



Conducted **2 listening sessions** for people to voice their challenges during COVID-19



Pivoted the in-person RW Part B consumer **priority setting process** to an online format to gather community feedback in a COVID-safe format



Formed a **clinical quality management work group** and an **employment work group** to assess services and challenges for PLWH
