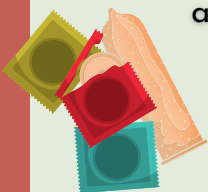


PREVENT HIV!

HIV IS TRANSMITTED BY BLOOD, SEMEN, RECTAL FLUIDS, VAGINAL SECRETIONS, & BREAST MILK

SEXUAL TRANSMISSION

HIV is only transmitted through sexual activities that involve exchange of the bodily fluids mentioned above.



When used the right way every time, condoms—both internal and external—are highly effective in preventing HIV.

INJECTION DRUG USE

Sharing needles and syringes can transmit HIV.



Use sterile needles and works **EVERY TIME** to prevent transmission of HIV and other blood-born viruses, like hepatitis B and C!

CHILDBIRTH & PREGNANCY



All pregnant people should be tested at every pregnancy. If a parent is HIV positive, HIV treatment can improve the health of the parent and prevent transmission to the baby.

Means of transmission



HIV positive body fluid



Portal of entry

= Possible HIV transmission

An exposure doesn't necessarily lead to a transmission. All the above factors must be true for HIV to be transmitted
