

IT TAKES **2** TESTS TO DIAGNOSE HEPATITIS C (HCV)

ANTIBODY TEST

This test looks for *antibodies*, which are made by the immune system.

A POSITIVE ANTIBODY TEST MEANS THAT SOMEONE HAS BEEN EXPOSED TO HCV.

RNA TEST

This test looks for hepatitis C *virus in the blood.*

A POSITIVE RNA TEST MEANS THAT SOMEONE CURRENTLY HAS HCV INFECTION.

The good news is that HCV can be cured!
