




  - HIV Summit on September 30<sup>th</sup> 2020 at Best Western Premier in Harrisburg. Looking for 200 attendees for one-day conference. May have larger conference in 2021.
- Will be transferring from PA NEDSS to a NEDSS Space system through the CDC. Planning is underway.
- Minority AIDS Initiative Update (MAI)
